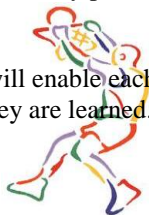

WHY INDIVIDUAL INSTRUCTION?

For an athlete to become better, they must dedicate time to doing the little things that will enable them to improve. The extra time spent perfecting the fundamentals of basketball will help any player to increase their versatility and value. My individual training is intended to help you take your game to the next level and help you achieve your own personal goals. The sessions are designed to identify and address weaknesses and improve strengths in a series of individual workouts.

WHAT DO THE SESSIONS ENTAIL?

The first few sessions will generally be spent in evaluating the student's skill level. Once this evaluation is complete, I will begin to structure the sessions around the student's current skill level. This will ensure a solid fundamental base to build and develop a better player. Ball handling, shooting, moving without the ball, passing, and defense are all skills that will be drilled on.

WHEN & WHERE DO THE SESSIONS TAKE PLACE?

I will normally meet with the student once or twice a week during a time that is agreeable for both parties on the campus of Central Christian College. Morning, afternoon, & evening hours are open any day of the week.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?
